- The final stage of forming up and sidewalks at the New Department of Works Building are being completed and there will be a ribbon cutting in a few weeks.
- Monday, December 26, 2011 the office will be closed in observance of Christmas.
- The City of Walker has partnered with LSU in a Christmas tree recycling project. Christmas trees can be dropped off from December 26<sup>th</sup> – January 6<sup>th</sup> at Sidney Hutchinson Park. Make sure all decorations are removed from the tree.
- There will be a meeting on the widening of Interstate 12 to Walker on Wednesday, December 14<sup>th</sup> at the Denham Springs/Walker Library at 1:00 pm.

- The City Council Meeting will be changed from Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday, January 10, 2012 at 7:00pm.

There being no additional comments or business to discuss, Mr. Richard Wales made a motion with a second by Mr. Elton Burns to adjourn.
