- Appliances (Refrigerators, Microwaves, etc.)
- Furniture
- Power Tools
- Medical Waste/All Medicines
- Insulation
- Propane Cylinders (anything over 5 gal)
- Gas Cylinders (oxygen, acetylene, etc.)
